



M86 Internet Filter Override Account Procedures

The following procedure details the steps necessary to utilize the M86 filter override account for the purpose of accessing educationally valuable information currently blocked. These procedures are only to be used by those educators who have completed the necessary "M86 Filter Override Account Request" form. When the M86 override has been invoked, all information both desirable and not desirable will be available for the specified period. Please use caution in protecting your unique username and password from students.

PROCEDURE:

1. When you receive the message from M86 that a desired site has been blocked, click on "click here" for further options.
