 - **172 passengers will leave on a chartered jet from Youngstown Airport approximately 6 pm on Thurs., April 3, 2008 in Sanford Airport. *(The charter from Miami Air is based on a fuel charge of \$2.10. For each \$.05 the fuel charge goes up, each passenger will be charged an additional \$1.75).***
 - **Approximately 28 passengers will fly from Pittsburgh on a Commercial flight on Air Tran into Orlando International Airport.**
 - ***(A committee of the band officers, band boosters, and band directors will discuss who will travel on the commercial flight. The decision of the directors is final).***
 - ***The cost of airfare has been calculated as a TOTAL for all travelers and has been divided equally among all travelers.***

\$100 Non-refundable deposit per person is due Oct. 29, 2007. {Though the deposit is non-refundable, if you find someone to “replace” you on the trip, they may pay the deposit to you with no financial penalty from the tour company}.

2nd payment--\$280.00—due Nov. 29, 2007

3rd payment--\$280.00—due Jan. 29, 2008

4th payment--\$135.00—due Feb. 15, 2008

Students who chose to participate in this trip must remain with the band throughout the trip. We are thrilled that many Howland parents will be traveling to see us perform, but students will not be released to travel elsewhere in Florida with parents for any reason.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

As stated above, all deposits are non-refundable. Other payments for the land package are refundable up to your final payment due date. After your final payment due date, all cancellations are in full penalty and the full package price must still be paid. AIRFARE IS NON-REFUNDABLE. We will make every effort to help you find a replacement traveler if you should be unable to travel with us.

Parents are asked to purchase at least 3 Disney Dining Cards for your child for 3 meals while in the Disney Parks. Since each child is different in his/her eating habits, you can purchase the amount you think he/she will need. We are recommending you buy 3--\$10.00 cards, one for each day. It will assure the directors that each child has money for food daily, and they don't spend it on souvenirs.

Description

The Disney Meal Card is similar to a prepaid credit card or gift card in that it starts off with a predetermined value and which carries a balance until the whole value is used up.

Purpose

To provide members of youth groups the opportunity to purchase meals and snacks during their stay on Disney property. By providing the meal card, your students are ensured that they will have funds to purchase food versus souvenirs or other items.

Locations

The Disney Meal Card may be used at any Disney-owned food-cart or restaurant on Disney Property that accepts credit cards.

Usage

Simply present the card at the time of payment for your food items or meals and the actual cost will be deducted from the balance remaining on the card.

Value

The Disney Meal Card is a “dollar for dollar” value and may be prepurchased with any dollar value from \$5.00 up.

Turn this form in with your deposit by Oct. 29, 2007. You may use your trip account.
