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Open Enrollment Application Procedures for the 2016-2017 School Year

- 1. Applications <u>for new students</u> may be picked up at the front desk of the administration offices, located at 8200 South Street SE, Warren, Monday through Friday, during business hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) <u>beginning March 01, 2016 through March 31, 2016</u>.
- 2. Applications are **not** to be completed in the administration offices when picked up.
- 3. The first day to return completed applications is Wednesday, March 02, 2016.
- Completed applications must be returned, <u>in person</u>, to the front desk of the administration offices during the business hours listed above, but no later than 4:00 p.m. on March 31, 2016. DO NOT FAX or MAIL completed applications.
- 5. Late applications will not be accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 6. One application must be completed, in full, for <u>each</u> child. <u>Separate copies</u> of requested information must be attached to <u>each</u> child's application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 7. Submission of an application for your child <u>does not guarantee</u> approval for open enrollment. Placement availability at all grade levels will vary based on Howland resident student enrollment within each grade. Enrollment will be on a limited basis for the 2016-2017 school year.
- 8. Applicants will receive <u>written notice</u> of the district's decision. The notice will be sent during the <u>first full week in June</u>, <u>2016</u>, for all grade levels.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to the high volume of open enrollment applications received, no information on the status of an application will be given over the telephone.

- 9. **Approvals are for one (1) school year only**. You must re-apply for open enrollment each school year.
- 10. Howland accepts open enrollment applications from all school age eligible students within the State of Ohio.
- 11. Students who have an outstanding financial obligation to their previous school or district <u>will not</u> <u>be eligible</u> for open enrollment.
- 12. <u>Transportation of students accepted under open enrollment shall be the sole responsibility of their parents/guardians</u>. If it is determined that there is seat availability on a bus, existing bus routes may be used to assist parents. Prior permission must be granted by the Howland Local Schools Transportation Department. <u>This determination of availability may not be made until approximately mid-September.</u>

For those persons applying for open enrollment for a child who will be entering **Kindergarten**:

Your child **must:**

- be five years old by September 30, 2016 and
- be **registered** in your public school district of residence.
