RECEIVE ALERTS!

You can now set alerts to notify you when your child has not completed an assignment or has received a low grade. Follow these steps below:

Step 1: On the "HOME" screen click on "ALERTS" located on the left side of the screen.

Step 2: On the "ALERTS" screen select the type of alerts you want to receive and then click "UPDATE".

Step 3: Click on "SET LOW MARK SETTINGS" and then the GRADE drop-down list to select a grade. If you want to be notified if your child receives a "B" or lower, select "B". Click "UPDATE".

An e-mail will be sent to your account associated with your ParentAccess.
